*** PAIRS FREESTYLE TO MUSIC - PAS DE DEUX**

Garlands provided by Broadway Park Equestrian Centre

Costumes may be worn as per Pony Club Gear Rules

Arena – 60m x 20m

Maximum Time allowed – 4 ½ minutes.

1. Body numbers and bridle numbers are not required for the Par de Deux.
2. Riders MUST supply a copy of the music in CD format clearly labeled and pre tested at home in a normal CD player.
3. Numbers for the Pas de Deux will be limited and early entries have preference.
4. Equality of scores: if two competitors receive the same final score, the one with the highest marks for artistic presentation is the winner
5. Markers will be placed around the arena as per the normal arena layout including AFBMCHEK and RSVP. It is not compulsory to use the markers.
6. It is important that competitors understand the Pas de Deux Event is for FUN ONLY.
7. Helmets always required.
8. Boots always required.
9. Armband always required.
10. Horse leg wear of any description is not permitted.
11. Spurs not permitted.



PLEASE NOTE:

For the EA Novice Freestyle to Music Test and Pas de Deux Competition at Ringwood Horse & Pony Club, the organizing committee will permit riders to wear a costume and decorate their horse according to the PCAV guidelines. These 2 classes have been sponsored by Broadway Park Equestrian Centre. Please enter early as rider numbers may be limited.

Some dressage sections may run at the same time as the musical rides. You may have to ride your test with music in the background.

Pony Club Riders must enter the Pony Club Graded Riders Section at their graded level; however, they can ride at any level in the Open sections.

Competitor numbers – the organizing committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers.
Competitors must supply their own back, bridle or saddle blanket numbers.

*** PCAV Grades 1, 2 & 3 Tests are NMZ State Qualifiers and NMZ Qualifiers in Levels 1,2 & 3 must ride 2 tests.**

Please put your entry in early, to avoid missing out.

HRC AV, Level 1-3 PCAV tests, Freestyle to Music Tests and all EA tests, except EA test Prep B, will be in 60m x 20m sized arenas.

Level 4 & 5 PCAV tests and EA Test Prep B will be in 40m x 20m arenas.

Conditions of Entry:

The competition consists of

- (a) **Graded Pony Club Rider Section (PCAV 2013 TESTS)** - you must ride at your PC Level
- (b) **Open Sections (PCAV 2013 & EA 2013/14 TESTS)** which are available to any rider

- ◆ **Medical Armbands are required to be worn by all competitors (Pony Club and Open)**
- ◆ Entering this competition (Sunday) constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- ◆ The organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- ◆ **Before riding:**
 - All open competitors must sign a Day Attendance Form (and Liability Declaration Form); and do not need to pay \$10.00 Day Attendance Fee if they are a current member of, and provide proof of membership of:**
 - **Pony Club Association of Victoria**
 - **Equestrian Australia**
 - **HRCAV**
 - **An interstate Pony Club**
 - **Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA)**
 - **Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA), or**
 - **Can provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.**
 - **All PCAV & EA cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.**
- ◆ All riders must pay the \$1 zone levy. This is included in entry fees.
- ◆ No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee.
- ◆ Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- ◆ All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
- ◆ Competitors must supply their own back, bridle or saddle cloth numbers.
- ◆ Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV (Sunday) Handbook of By-Laws.
- ◆ No dogs allowed.
- ◆ Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively subject to ballot of entries. Please fill out 1 entry per combination and indicate preference or order of horses.
- ◆ PCAV Riders competing in any open section, must sign the day attendance form. Parent/Guardians also need to sign if participant is under 18 years of age.
- ◆ Pony Club riders may ride in both Pony Club and Open sections on the same horse.
- ◆ PCAV Alcohol Policy applies
- ◆ In the Open tests Riders may wear Pony Club Uniforms or Jackets.
- ◆ Horses can only be lunged in the small arena on the north side of grounds.
- ◆ All Riders must present for gear check at least 15 minutes before each Dressage test.
- ◆ Please check your Dressage Times on the Day and be prepared to ride earlier, if classes are running ahead of time.
- ◆ The event to be run under Pony Club Rules - No stallions, colts or rigs allowed.

DAY PARTICIPANT WAIVER 2016-2017

Participants in events organised by PCAV Clubs, who are not current financial members of a PCAV Club, or who do not have any other approved insurance in place, upon completion of this form are deemed to be "Day Participants" of the event. Protection is afforded to the Day Participant under the PCAV Public Liability policy, only whilst participating in activities organised and/or run by the PCAV Club at that event, where they are liable for causing bodily injury or property damage to others, excluding whilst travelling to and from such event.

By signing this form, you agree to abide by the Rules & Conditions of the PCAV and any Rules of the event. For every Entrant who does NOT have a current and proven Public Liability insurance to the minimum of \$10,000.00 a payment is due of \$10.00 per person per day (including GST), to cover the cost of participation with this Pony Club for each day of this event.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

I, the undersigned, in consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, acknowledge and accept that:
Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt.
There is a significant risk that serious injury or death may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event and freely assume all such risks, even if arising from the negligence of PCAV and/or the event organiser / official.
I voluntarily participate at my own risk and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse no matter where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this event and the official Rule Book of the Pony Club Association of Victoria. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify PCAV against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Pony Club Association of Victoria and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document - I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.

In consideration of your accepting my participation, I hereby undertake to indemnify the organising body against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the organising body by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider, driver, trainer or attendant whilst he/she is attending, riding, driving or otherwise handling any horse so entered or any other horse owned or entered by me, and I agree that any act or omission on the part of such rider, driver, handler or attendant found in any action against you to be negligent shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity.

Further, I agree to abide by the Rules & Conditions and current Rule Book as laid down by the Pony Club Association of Victoria and/or contained in any official event schedule and I also agree to abide by all of the Event Venue rules regarding use of their centre and its facilities.
