Levels 4 & 5 PCAV tests will be in 40m x 20m arenas

All EV tests, will be in 60m x 20m sized arenas.

Competitors must supply their own back, bridle or saddle blanket numbers.

Conditions of Entry:

The competition consists of

- (a) **Graded Pony Club Rider Section (PCAV 2013 TESTS plus amendments)** - you must ride at your PC Level
- (b) **OPEN EA Section (2019 Tests and Preparatory Tests from 2013)**

All Dressage Tests may be called.

- ◆ Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- ◆ The organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- ◆ Horses must be at least 4yrs
- ◆ **Before riding:**
All Pony Club Riders must provide proof of membership of Pony Club Association of Victoria
Membership cards must be handed in at the secretary's office.

Open Riders

- a. Everybody fills in the Liability Declaration Form
- b. \$15 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member* of EV/EA; HRCav; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. ***Must produce proof.**
- c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$15 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the Participant Waiver.
- d. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.

PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.

- ◆ OPEN RIDERS MUST COMPLETE A PCAV WAIVER.
- ◆ All riders must pay the \$1 zone levy. This is included in entry fees.
- ◆ No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee.
- ◆ Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- ◆ Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCAV Gear Rules, incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
- ◆ A Gear Checks will be required prior the first test in each section.
- ◆ Competitors must supply their own back, bridle or saddle cloth numbers. They must be on both sides of the horse
- ◆ Lungeing is not permitted at this competition
- ◆ Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
- ◆ No dogs allowed.
- ◆ Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively subject to ballot of entries. Please fill out 1 entry per combination and indicate preference or order of horses.
- ◆ PCAV Alcohol Policy applies
- ◆ All Riders must present for gear check at least 15 minutes before the first Dressage test.
- ◆ Please check your Dressage Times on the Day and be prepared to ride earlier, if classes are running ahead of time.
- ◆ No stallions, colts or rigs allowed.
- ◆ All entries subject to Bio security rules.
